



### For the consumer

#### **Positioning**

The anthurium needs to be placed in a light spot, but not in direct sunlight. If the plant's position is too dark, the plant will produce fewer flowers.

#### Water

It is best to water your Anthurium moderately and regularly once or twice a week. The soil should not be completely dry, but must remain moist (brown colour). If the plant is too wet, the soil will be black.

#### Old leaves and flowers

Anthurium produces fresh flowers and leaves. The old leaves and flowers discolour after a while.


Simply remove yellowed leaves and wilted flowers. If the plant's leaves are shiny and it is producing new flowers, you can conclude that the plant is in suitable conditions. The care determines the lifespan and decorative value of the plant.



# Pot Phalaenopsis Standard Flowering











### For the consumer

#### **Positioning**

Place the plant in a position where it gets enough light, but avoid bright sunlight. Do not place the plant in direct sunlight. Room temperature is best suited, making it an indoor plant.

#### Water

Water your Phalaenopsis orchids early in the morning. This ensures complete water evaporation on the foliage as well as the crown by nightfall. Phalaenopsis require watering about once every 4 to 7 days. Plants should never stand in water. Plants that stand in water or that are watered in the evening will develop bacterial or fungal rot.

#### Other information

The Phalaenopsis may grow air roots outside the pot. This is not a bad sign - on the contrary, it suggests that the plant is happy. You can simply leave the air roots where they are. They do not need to be removed or pushed back into the pot. In fact, this is more likely to damage the plant.

#### **Positioning**

Keep your Bromeliad in a bright spot, but it should be placed away from direct sunlight. Too much sunlight will cause brown burn spots on the leaves. Bromeliad prefers warm temperatures, making it a popular choice as an indoor house plant.


#### Water

Watering Bromeliads is different then most house plants. They take their water through the leaves rather than the roots Instead of watering near the base of the plant, Pour water into the centre of the plant. Keep the soil moist but never let it get soggy. Don't water the bromeliad again until at least the top two inches of potting media are dry. Over watering will cause rotting of roots and foliage dropping.

#### Other information

Bromeliads only flower once. These plants are quite unique in the fact that they get their nourishment from the air rather than the soil.

Keep the plants clean by pulling the old leaves off the base with a sideways action and this helps keep pests away.
